Enclosed please find information regarding the 24th Annual IAM Guide Dogs of America Golf Tournament, sponsored by the International Association of Machinists District Lodge W24. The event will be held Monday, September 10, 2012, in Portland, Oregon, as a benefit to Guide Dogs of America, headquartered in Sylmar, California.

Guide Dogs of America was founded in 1948, and continues its mission today to provide guide dogs and instruction in their use, free of charge, to blind and visually impaired men and women from the United States and Canada so that they may continue to pursue their goals with increased mobility and independence. GDA is funded wholly by contributions from individuals, corporations, foundations, chapters and clubs; it receives no government funding.

While the guide dog partner and training are free of charge to the recipient, it costs about \$42,000 to raise and train each dog, along with the tremendous efforts of many volunteers.
